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Credit Recovery Program:

1.00 Teacher/English, 1.00 Teacher/Social Studies, 1.00 Teacher/Mathematics, and 1.00 Teacher/Science for each of the following schools: Burch High School, Gilbert High School, Matewan High School, Tug Valley High School, and Williamson High School. (Requires certification appropriate to teach these core academic areas.) 1.00 Teacher/French for Mingo County Schools. (Requires certification in French). These teachers will assist students who are unsuccessful in earning academic credit towards graduation. In addition, they will supervise and facilitate coursework in current classes only. Credit Recovery will utilize teacher collaboration for each student using an asynchronous model with small group instruction, project based learning, online modules, and portfolio development.

Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 until 5:00 on an as/if needed basis, at the rate of \$25.00 per hour. Students will be with teachers from 3:00-4:30. Teachers will plan and grade portfolio work from 4:30-5:00.

After-School Program:

1.00 Teacher/English and 1.00 Teacher/Mathematics for each of the following schools: Burch High School, Gilbert High School, Kermit K-8 School, Lenore K-8 School, Matewan High School, Matewan Middle School, Tug Valley High School, Williamson High School, and Williamson Middle School. (Requires certification appropriate to teach these core academic areas.)

Tuesdays and Thursdays, on an as/if needed basis, at the rate of \$25.00 per hour, for 1.5 hours each session (for students). Teachers will work an extra 1/2 hour per session to look at student work and make adjustments in designing instructional responses for student learning. Teachers will be required to keep an instructional matrix on student deficiencies and accomplishments, as well as provide written feedback on student portfolio submissions.
