1.00 Teacher/English, 1.00 Teacher/Social Studies, 1.00 Teacher/Mathematics, and 1.00 Teacher/Science for each of the following schools: Burch High School, Gilbert High School, Matewan High School, Tug Valley High School, and Williamson High School. (Requires certification appropriate to teach these core academic areas.) These teachers will assist students who are unsuccessful in earning academic credit towards graduation. In addition, they will supervise and facilitate coursework in current classes only. Credit Recovery will utilize teacher collaboration for each student using an asynchronous model with small group instruction, project based learning, online modules, and portfolio development.

Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 until 5:00 on an as/if needed basis, at the rate of \$25.00 per hour. Students will be with teachers from 3:00-4:30. Teachers will plan and grade portfolio work from 4:30-5:00.
