

Set Base Reading Speed (BRS) Options.

The Base Reading Speed (BRS) for a student represents their current reading speed. Drills can pace them at higher speeds relative to their personal BRS. The BRS for a student is determined from their most recent “qualified” self-paced reading comprehension test result. Their BRS is the speed in which they read the story while taking the test. Test results are “qualified” using the filter criteria specified below.

Examples of why you may want to filter low or high speeds:

Extremely low speeds may result if a student walks away from the computer while they were taking a timed self-paced test. Extremely high speeds may result if they did not actually read the story and if they quickly hit the Done button while the story was being presented.
