Guidelines For Selling Items

- 1. Tags must be purchased through the Community Education office. Tags are sold in increments of 100 tags for \$20.00, 75 tags for \$15.00, 50 tags for \$10.00 or 25 tags for \$5.00. You are responsible for affixing your tags to the item(s) you bring in. If you purchase 100 tags you are allowed to bring 100 items, 50 tags; 50 items and 25 tags; 25 items. (ex: one shirt counts as one item) Once you purchase your tags through the Community Education office your name will be assigned a number and that will be the financial tracking system. The deadline to purchase tags is the Wednesday prior to the sale.
- 2. Items must be marked in .25 increments. (.25, .50, .75, \$1.00, \$1.25, etc.)
- 3. All items must be in good condition: no rips, holes, or stains. *Items in poor condition will be pulled from the sale*. All toys must be in working condition and include all pieces.
- 4. Tags to be affixed by pins or tape. We are not responsible for tags that fall off or are not affixed properly.) NO STAPLES ALLOWED.
- 6. Items may be dropped off at the Cafeteria Gymnasium the Friday before the sale from 2:00 6:00pm. You will be responsible to put your sale items out in the designated and marked areas upon arrival.
- 7. All unsold items must be picked up immediately following sale from 3:00 4:00pm. You must be back at school to pick up your unsold items or designate somebody else to pick up for you.
- 8. You will be reimbursed for all items sold the following week by McGregor schools.
