MacBean is a colour painting application for the Macintosh.

MacBean was developed entirely by me as an experiment - I wanted to see if I could write a useful application. I also wanted to provide some justification for buying the book "Mac Programming FAQs", which, at the time, cost a fair bit more than I could afford to spend! The code was developed with the aid of the sample code provided with that book. The name comes from an IRC user using the nickname MacBean some years ago.
