

Install Guard

System watch utility for use with installation programs.

This utility was designed for use with my archiver WZT95.

Its free for personal use at your own risk, but remember this.

No warranties are expressed or implied for its use.

This program watches for system changes while another program installs. You can then run the new application and afterwards display the changes and optionally uninstall them.

I wrote it for use with WZT95 to run the setup programs contained in many zip files.

I am not supporting the use of this program as a stand alone, but it does have some capability to do so.

Examples for stand alone usage:

A. Exe files that start an installation process.

Select the desired file from the list controls then press RUN.

B. Files with inf extensions.

Check the Guard Only box.

Press RUN.

Wait till you see the Install Guard Waiting dialog. (YOU MUST WAIT)

Use explorer to navigate to the inf file. Right click on it and choose install.

C. Self Extracting Dos Archives.

The self extractor will run in a DOS box and decompress itself in whatever directory its in.

Since its a DOS app I am not certain if WiGuard can monitor this in all cases.

If you suspect a file of this type copy or move it to another location before running it.
