On my next birthday (three months later) I got the "Action Replay MKIII". I miss it on my A1200 now. It's an unique thing, but my little brother got it now. So it's not really lost. :-)

After a long pain (swapping disks from drive to drive...) the deliverence was near: An A1200 with 120MB HD was advertised. Fortunately the advertiser lived in my VILLAGE (~650 people), but I didn't know him! So I visited him immediately and one day later I got an A1200 with 120MB Hard-disk full of tools (nice to investigate it ;-). Now life was much easier. That was at Christmas Day '94.

Today my complete configuration is like this:
