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

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### What is Vault?

Vault stores your information as an outline. Vault organizes your information into categories and subcategories that you specify.

For example, the Vault file below has "Calendar" and "Computer" categories. Under the "Computer" category are sub-categories of "Hardware", "On-Line Services", and "Software". Under "Hardware" is "Micron", and under "Micron" are "BBS" and "Notes". Since the "Notes" item has been selected, the text for that item is displayed in the text window at the bottom of the screen.



Vault's search command finds the information you need instantly. You can also browse the outline by expanding and collapsing items.

Vault's Send command allows you to send your notes to co-workers via electronic mail.

Vault's Dial Phone command automatically dials the phone number in the current outline item.

Vault's Print command allows you to specify which notes to print, and how they should appear. Vault's Print Preview command allows you to inspect the appearance of printouts before sending them to the printer.

### **How to Use Vault**


# Opening a File

To open a Vault file, use the <u>File / Open</u> command. You may want to open "EXAMPLE.VLT" to learn how to use Vault.

### **Creating a New File**

To create a new Vault file, use the File / New command.

Vault has two windows separated by a movable "splitter bar". The top window is the outline window, and the bottom window is the text window:



For further information on the splitter bar, see Move Split.

### The Outline Window

### **Selecting Items**

Items in the outline window can be expanded and contracted by double-clicking them with the mouse. For further information, see <a href="Outline/Expand">Outline / Expand</a> and <a href="Outline/Collapse">Outline / Collapse</a>.

To select an outline item, move the mouse pointer over it and press the left mouse button once. When you select one outline item, that item's text will appear in the text window.

To select a range of items, select the first item with the mouse. Then hold down the shift key and select the last item with the mouse.

To select multiple, non-contiguous outline items, hold down the Ctrl key and select items with the mouse. If you accidentally select the wrong item, just click it once again with the mouse.

When you select multiple items, the text window will be blank.

### **Adding and Deleting Items**

To add new outline items, use the <u>Outline / Add Above</u> and <u>Outline / Add Below</u> commands. To delete outline items, use the <u>Outline / Delete Items</u> command. To change an item's title, use the <u>Outline / Change Title</u> command.

### **Indenting and Un-Indenting Outline Items**

To change the indentation of outline items, use the Outline / Indent and Outline / Un-indent commands.

### **Cutting, Pasting, and Copying**

To cut, paste, and copy outline items, use the <u>Outline / Cut Items</u>, <u>Outline / Paste Items</u>, and <u>Outline / Copy Items</u> commands.

#### The Text Window

The text window displays the current outline item's text and allows you to edit it. For further information, see <a href="Edit / Undo">Edit / Cut</a>, <a href="Edit / Undo">Edit / Cut</a>, <a href="Edit / Losert Date">Edit / Losert Date</a>, <a

# Searching

Use the Outline / Search command to search for items.

# **Printing**

Use the File / Print Preview and File / Print commands to preview and print your Vault file.

### Saving a File

Use the File / Save and File / Save As commands to save your Vault file.

### **Sending Outline Items via Electronic Mail**

To send outline items via electronic mail, select the items and use the File / Send command.


### **Dialing the Phone**

To automatically dial a phone number, select the item containing the phone number and use the <u>Outline / Dial Phone</u> command.

### The Toolbar

The toolbar is displayed across the top of the application window, below the menu bar. The toolbar provides quick mouse access to many Vault commands. If you leave the mouse above a toolbar button for a moment, help for that button will be displayed.

To hide or display the Toolbar, choose Toolbar from the Options menu (Alt, p, T).



### Click To

- Open a new document.
- Open an existing document. Vault displays the Open dialog box, in which you can locate and open the desired file.
- Save the active document with its current name. If you have not named the document, Vault displays the Save As dialog box.
- Print the active document.
- Send the selected outline items through electronic mail.
- Dial the phone number in the current outline item's text.
- Add a new outline item above the selected item.
- Add a new outline item below the selected item.
- Delete the selected outline items.
- Indent the selected outline items.
- Un-indent the selected outline items.
- a-z Sort all outline items in alphabetical order.
- Get information about moving outline items.
- Change the title of the selected outline item.
- Delete the selected outline items, but allow subsequent pasting.
- Copy the selected outline items for subsequent pasting.
- Insert previously-cut outline items in a new position.
- Search for outline items containing specific text.
- View outline items found by previous search.

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# The Status Bar



The status bar is displayed at the bottom of the Vault window. To display or hide the status bar, use the <a href="Options/Status Bar">Options / Status Bar</a> command.

The left area of the status bar describes actions of menu items as you use the arrow keys to navigate through menus. This area similarly shows messages that describe the actions of toolbar buttons as you depress them, before releasing them. If after viewing the description of the toolbar button command you wish not to execute the command, then release the mouse button while the pointer is off the toolbar button.

The right areas of the status bar indicate which of the following keys are latched down:

Indicator	Description
CAP	The Caps Lock key is latched down.
NUM	The Num Lock key is latched down.
SCRL	The Scroll Lock key is latched down.

Use this command to open an existing Vault document.

You can create new documents with the File / New command.

# **Dialog Box:**

The following options allow you to specify which file to open:

### File Name

Type or select the filename you want to open. This box lists files with the extension you select in the List Files of Type box.

### **List Files of Type**

Select the type of file you want to open. If you are opening a Vault file, select "Vault Files". If you are inserting a text file, select "Text Files".

### **Drives**

Select the drive that contains the file that you want to open.

#### **Directories**

Select the directory that contains the file that you want to open.

#### Network..

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

### **Shortcuts**

Toolbar: № Keys: CTRL+O

# File / Save

Use this command to save the active document to its current name and directory. When you save a document for the first time, Vault displays the <u>Save As dialog box</u> so you can name your document. If you want to change the name and directory of an existing document before you save it, choose the <u>Save As command</u>.

### **Shortcuts**

Toolbar: ₩ Keys: CTRL+S

Use this command to save and name the active document. Vault displays the <u>Save As dialog box</u> so you can name your document.

To save a document with its existing name and directory, use the Save command.

### **Dialog Box:**

The following options allow you to specify the name and location of the file you're about to save:

### **File Name**

Type a new filename to save a document with a different name. A filename can contain up to eight characters and an extension of up to three characters. Vault adds the extension you specify in the Save File As Type box.

#### **Drives**

Select the drive in which you want to store the document.

#### **Directories**

Select the directory in which you want to store the document.

### Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

Use this dialog box to specify what to print:

#### Set Font

Press this button to select a printer font. See Font Dialog Box for further information.

### **Set Margins**

Press this button to specify margins. See <u>Margins Dialog Box</u> for further information.

### **Second Print Dialog Box:**

The following options allow you to specify how the document should be printed:

### **Printer**

This is the active printer and printer connection. Choose the Setup option to change the printer and printer connection.

### Setup

Displays a Print Setup dialog box, so you can select a printer and printer connection.

# **Print Range**

Specify the pages you want to print:

All Prints the entire document.

Selection Prints the currently selected text.

**Pages** Prints the range of pages you specify in the From and To boxes.

# Copies

Specify the number of copies you want to print for the above page range.

### **Collate Copies**

Prints copies in page number order, instead of separated multiple copies of each page.

# **Print Quality**

Select the quality of the printing. Generally, lower quality printing takes less time to produce.

### File / Print Preview

Use this command to display the active document as it would appear when printed. When you choose this command, the main window will be replaced with a print preview window in which one or two pages will be displayed in their printed format. The print preview toolbar offers you options to view either one or two pages at a time; move back and forth through the document; zoom in and out of pages; and initiate a print job.

### Dialog Box:

Use this dialog box to specify what to print:

Select To

Print Outline Just print outline items

Print Text Just print text

Print Outline and Text Print both outline items and text

Print Selected Items Print selected outline items

Print All Items Print all items

#### **Set Font**

Press this button to select a printer font. See Font Dialog Box for further information.

### **Set Margins**

Press this button to specify margins. See Margins Dialog Box for further information.

### **Print Preview Toolbar:**

The print preview toolbar offers you the following options:

#### **Print**

Bring up the print dialog box, to start a print job.

### **Next Page**

Preview the next printed page.

### **Prev Page**

Preview the previous printed page.

### One Page / Two Page

Preview one or two printed pages at a time.

#### Zoom In

Take a closer look at the printed page.

### **Zoom Out**

Take a larger look at the printed page.

### Close

Return from print preview to the editing window.

# File / Print Setup

Use this command to select a printer and a printer connection. This command presents a print setup dialog box, where you specify the printer and its connection.

### **Print Setup Dialog Box:**

The following options allow you to select the destination printer and its connection:

### **Printer**

Select the printer you want to use. Choose the Default Printer; or choose the Specific Printer option and select one of the current installed printers shown in the box. You install printers and configure ports using the Windows Control Panel.

#### Orientation

Choose Portrait or Landscape.

### **Paper Size**

Select the size of paper that the document is to be printed on.

### **Paper Source**

Some printers offer multiple trays for different paper sources. Specify the tray here.

### **Options**

Displays a dialog box where you can make additional choices about printing, specific to the type of printer you have selected.

### Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

Use this command to e-mail the selected outline items to other users. This feature is available if MAPI-based e-mail software is installed on your machine.

# **Shortcuts**

# File / Export

Use this command to save the selected outline items in a text file.

# File / Open Previously-Opened File

Use the numbers and filenames listed at the bottom of the File menu to open the last four documents you closed. Choose the number that corresponds with the document you want to open.

# File / Exit

Use this command to end your Vault session. You can also use the Close command on the application Control menu. Vault prompts you to save documents with unsaved changes.

Cutting text to the clipboard replaces the contents previously stored there.

# **Shortcuts**

# **Edit / Copy**

Use this command to copy selected text onto the clipboard. This command is unavailable if there is no text currently selected.

Copying text to the clipboard replaces the contents previously stored there.

# **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+C

# **Edit / Paste**

Use this command to insert a copy of the clipboard contents at the insertion point. This command is unavailable if the clipboard is empty.

# **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+V

# **Edit / Select All**

Use this command to select the entire contents of the text window. Once selected, the text can be copied or replaced with other text.

#### **Find Next**

Press this button find the next occurrence of the text entered in the Find What box.

#### Replace

Press this button to replace the selected text with the text in the Replace With box.

# Replace All

Choose this option to replace all occurrences of the Find What text with the Replace With text.

### Cancel

Quits finding and replacing text.

Gives help on the Replace command.







Use this command to open an outline item and show its subordinate items. Only items that are drawn as closed books can be expanded.

An item can also be expanded by double-clicking it with the mouse.

For example, double-clicking the "Micron" item:



opens it and reveals its subordinate items, "BBS" and "Notes":

For example, double-clicking the "Micron" item:

Use this command to change an outline item's title. An item must be selected before its title can be changed. For example, to change the title of the "Calendar" item to "Personal Calendar", first select it by clicking it with the mouse:



Then select the Outline / Change Title command (or press the "Change Title" toolbar button). The following dialog box will be displayed, allowing you to change the title:



After the OK button is pressed, the title is changed:

Use this command to delete outline items. Once cut, the items can be subsequently pasted in another place in the outline. Items must be selected before they can be cut.

Use this command to delete outline items. Items must be selected before they can be deleted.

Press this button if you dont want to delete the current outline item.

### Cancel

Press this button to stop deleting outline items.

### **Outline / Sort All Items**

Use this command to arrange all outline items in ascending alphabetical order.

If there are items with dates in their titles, they will be sorted into alphabetical order, not chronological order. To prevent this, enter dates in the form YYMMDD at the start of titles.

For example, the following items will stay in chronological order after sorting:

- "19950202 Presentation to User's Group"
- "19950302 Vendor Negotiations"
- "19950727 Design Review"

The following items will not stay in chronological order after sorting:

"February 2, 1995 Presentation to User's Group"

"March 2, 1995 Vendor Negotiations"

Select this option to find only text that matches the exact combination of uppercase and lowercase letters entered in the Search for box.

Press this button to begin the search.

#### Cancel

Press this button to cancel the search.

Once the search is complete, the Search Results dialog box is displayed:

## **Search Results Dialog Box:**

#### Items found

List of all outline items that contain the search text.

#### Go To Item

Press this button to go to the selected outline item.

You can also do this by double-clicking the outline's title.

### **New Search**

Press this button to begin a new search.

#### Close

Press this button to close the Search Results dialog box.

#### **Outline / Dial Phone**

Use this command to automatically dial a phone number. To dial the phone, select the outline item containing the telephone number. Make sure that the telephone number is the first thing in the text window. The telephone number must be the only thing on the first line:



<u>The Dial Phone command requires Windows 95.</u> Also, make sure that you've installed the Windows 95. Phone Dialer, and make sure that it works properly.

To install the Phone Dialer, go to the Start menu. Select the Settings item and the Control Panel item. Double-click the "Add/Remove Programs" icon in the Control Panel. Select the Windows Setup tab. Double-click the "Communications" item. Finally, check the "Phone Dialer" check box and press the OK button.

Your phone must be connected to the "Phone" jack in back of your modem. TAPI-compliant telephones can also be used.

Make sure the number has been completely dialed before lifting the receiver.
