How can you live with yourself and call yourself a leader when this injustice perpetuates itself all around you daily in your own back yard? Where is your sense of justice? Do you yourself benefit somehow from the trickle of wealth which is fed by the persecution of your fellow Americans in the name of this so-called War On Drugs? If not, why do you fail to speak loudly and often against such cowardly acts? Perhaps you lack true leadership courage, which is how it looks to those millions of us who at any moment could easily be locked up and our lives disrupted or even ruined while people like you who could defend us do nothing.
