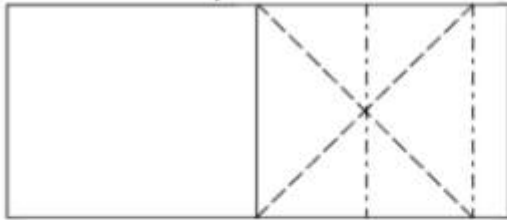
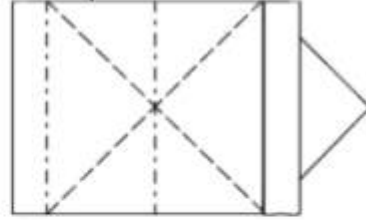


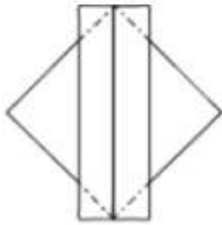

1. Fold like a waterbomb base with a little flap.

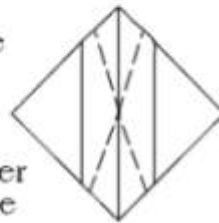


2. Repeat step one on the left.



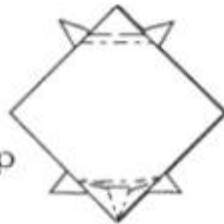
3. Mountain fold under the top layer only.

4. Valley fold. The top flippers are slimmer and the edge slants up, while on the thicker bottom flippers the edge is nearly horizontal.

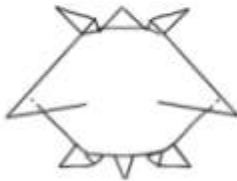


5. Flip over.

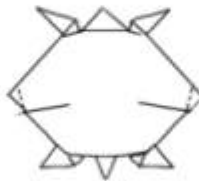
6. The top point is pleated and the sharp edges rounded with little inside reverse folds. The bottom is folded like a pleat where the sides of the point are mountain folded to make the tail slimmer as in fig. 7



7. The horizontal center line is folded back to make darts on either side. You can elevate the center of the shell by extending the darts closer to or right up to the center.



8. Mountain fold the points and tuck between layers.



9. Mountain fold the remaining points under to round off the shell.
