Word Square Game Menu

New Game	Start a new game.
Replay Game	Replay the current game.
Select Game	Start one of the over 32000 games.
Contest	Start the special Contest game.
High Scores	Display the high scores table.
Exit	Exit the Word Square program.

How To Play

The objective of Word Square is to score the highest possible score by placing the letter tiles to form three, four, or five letter words. Words can be horizontal or vertical and ALL three, four, and five letter words are scored (even if they are in a larger word).

Here's what you score:

2 points for 3 letter words.
5 points for 4 letter words.
10 points for 5 letter words.

Place the tiles by clicking the location on the game board with the cursor. The game's dictionary is the final arbiter of what constitutes a valid word. Words formed by adding an 's' are not included in the dictionary (you can't get more points by making it plural).

Using the Keyboard

If you choose to you can place the tiles using the arrow keys to move the cursor from block to block and pressing either the Spacebar or the Enter key.
