Guidelines for iMovie 2.1.1 for Mac OS X, 10.1 or Higher

In the chart below, indicate “Pass” or “Fail.” All Verification conditions must be met before declaring “Pass” for each step.

#	Action	Verification	iMac	iBook	Power Mac	Power Book
1	Put iMovie into camera mode.	Is “Camera Connected” displayed in the iMovie Viewer?				
2	Click Play button in iMovie.	Does video play in iMovie Viewer? Video should be the same as that displayed in the camera.				
3	Click Stop button in iMovie.	Does tape stop and iMovie display, “Camera Connected” with same time-code as camera?				
4	Click Pause button in iMovie.	Does paused frame appear in iMovie Viewer?				
5	Click Rewind button in iMovie.	Does tape rewind?				
6	Click Stop button in iMovie.	Does tape stop?				
7	Click Fast-forward button in iMovie.	Does tape fast-forward?				
8	Click Stop button in iMovie.	Does tape stop?				
9	Click Import while camera is playing.	Is the video displayed in iMovie Viewer? Does first frame of movie appear in shelf?				
10	Click Import to Stop Import.	Does the camera continue to play after import is pressed again?				
11	Click Import again while camera is playing.	Does the second clip appear in the Shelf while importing?				
12	Click Stop while iMovie is importing.	Does the camera and import function stop? iMovie should display “Camera Connected.”				
13	Put camera into Camera Mode and click Import.	Does iMovie capture live footage from camera? (Some cameras require a tape inserted.)				
14	Put Camera in VTR mode. Click Stop, then Import.	Does the camera go into Play mode and Import into iMovie?				
15	Choose Export from File menu. Enter 5 seconds in all fields. Click Export.	Does the camera go into Record mode and does iMovie show the Export status bar?				
16	Click Export with no tape in camera.	Does the warning dialog, “Your camera appears to have no tape inserted, or may be a converter box” appear?				
17	Click Export with a write protected tape in camera.	Does the warning dialog, “Your tape may be write protected. Proceed with export” appear?				
18	Disconnect and reconnect camera in VTR mode.	Does iMovie Viewer say, “Camera Disconnected”? After reconnecting, is device control re-established? (You may need to turn camera off and on again.)				
19	Press camera transport controls: play, pause, etc.	Does iMovie Viewer display correct video? Is the corresponding iMovie button highlighted?
