This Print2Pict extension creates Pixmap PICT files from printed page.

The picture is drawn in an offscreen pixmap. This pixmap is then saved has a PICT file, but the original vector composing the image are then lost.

This extension uses a lot of memory. A standard sheet of paper is about  $800 \times 600$  pixels. In 256 colors mode, the extension must allocate  $800 \times 600$  bytes = 480000 bytes, plus the same size for the resulting picture and the size of the original picture.
