Word 8.0 (Office 97) Button Images

This is an update to my previous toolbar button image macro for Word 7.0. This version creates 12 (yes, 12) separate toolbars containing all available toolbar images through image number 2400. Not all of the buttons contain images and some of them are probably duplicates, but it is still *quite* a collection...

I didn't go any further than 2400, but there are probably more button images available. If anyone feels inclined to push on, I'd be interested in knowing where it finally ends. Please drop me a note at rksymo@gte.net.

The "create toolbars" part of this is a bit of a kludge. I didn't use VBA, but rather kept the converted macro format using the WordBasic object instead. As soon as I figure out how to do the same thing using VBA, I'll update it.

I used ActiveX command buttons here instead of macro button field codes. Although the create bitmaps macro is still attached to the template, I didn't update it. It shouldn't take too much to update it if you really feel you need it.

If I get the time, I'm going to modify this whole thing so that you can "scroll" through the buttons automatically, one "page" at a time.

You do still receive a "Bad Parameter" error if you try to run the macro a second time without first deleting the previously created toolbars, but since there *are* so many toolbars, I recorded a macro to get rid of them for you too...
