Response to "Suchtime.txt" messages from David G.

David, I do not doubt that something possibly horrific will occur on June 9th. But rather than Rev. 8:5, lets look at other Scriptures to decide where your messages have been coming from.

Rev. 22:18: "I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book."

Rev. 13:13-14: "And he performed great and miraculous signs, even causing fire to come down from heaven to earth in full view of men. Because of the signs he was given power to do on behalf of the first beast, he deceived the inhabitants of the earth."

2Cor.11:14-15: "Satan himself masquerades as an angel [messenger] of light. It is not surprising, then, if his servants masquerade as servants of righteousness."

Daniel 11:32a: "With flattery he will corrupt those who have violated the covenant,"

Gal. 1:8: "if we or an angel [messenger] from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let him be eternally condemned."

Question: Why would the Lord need to repeat His words, or those similar, when God has already written them in the Scriptures, for all to read?

Answer: The Lord does'nt. His followers read the Scriptures (1John 2:3) and will not need additional revelation (Rev.22:18) in order to be prepared. The message is from the "spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms." (i.e. the followers of Satan) Eph 6:10-18. God has ever increasingly let Satan do as he pleases because God's salvation plan is coming to an end (Rev.11:7), and Judgment Day is around the corner. Satan is the father of lies (Jn8:44), and he comes with massive deception-and knows the scriptures quite well (Luke 4:9-11). God has spoken in His Word , the Bible, concerning the time we are in, about Satans deception plans, and what His people will go through (Matt 24:21-22;Luke 21:36) and how His people are not to worry (Matt.24:6;Ps 49:5,57:16;Philip.4:4-9) , and what the True Gospel is (2Tim.3: 16).
