Newt Backs Down

The Jerusalem Embassy Act requiring that the United States move its embassy to Jerusalem by May 31, 1999 was passed by over two-thirds of the Senate and House of Representatives who voted in favor of acknowledging Jerusalem as Israel's eternal capital.
