Customize your poster for maximum impact

You can choose to print the materials as they are, or customize them with your text information. Use a vendor like Kinko's or Sir Speedy, or print and customize the PDF templates on your own.

To add your custom information, you will need Adobe Acrobat, version 4.0 or higher.

To add your information:

1. Open the file Poster.pdf using Adobe Acrobat.
2. Click on the provided text area, select the text "Insert text here". You also have the option of deleting this field completely so that the piece has no customization at all.
3. Begin typing in your information.
 - Note:** You are limited to a maximum of 2 lines of text here.
 - Suggestion:** use the vertical slash "|" as a design element to separate each information component.
 - Example:** Parent Discussion | April 2, 2004 | Miller Auditorium
4. Print your customized poster in color, on Tabloid (11" x 17") heavy stock paper.
