This macro will convert a number to a label or a label to a number. To use it place the cursor in the cell you want to convert and press and hold the macro key (the Alt key on most computers) and press the "C" key. The contents of the cell will be converted from a label to a number or if a number to a label.

To invoke the macro hold down the macro key (Alt on most computers) and press the "C" key.

If you combined this with another spreadsheet you will have to name the cell to the right of the \C to \C. To do this place the cursor on the \C and press slash (/), Range (R), Name (N), Labels (L), Right (R), and Enter. This will name the cell to the right of \C to \C.
