`\E {?}{DOWN}/XG\E~`

A basic data entry macro.

This macro is very usefull for entering numbers on a PC without a seperate number pad. To use it place the cursor where you want to begin entering numbers, invoke the macro, put Num-lock on and start entering numbers. The cursor will then go down to the next cell and be ready for another number each time you press the Enter key.

You may change the "DOWN" to "RIGHT", "LEFT", or "UP" to change the direction of movement.

To invoke the macro hold down the macro key (Alt on most computers) and press the "E" key.

If you combined this with another spreadsheet you will have to name the cell to the right of the \E to \E. To do this place the cursor on the \E and press slash (/), Range (R), Name (N), Lables (L), Right (R), and Enter. THIS will name the cell to the right of \E to \E.
