## Respond to a Scenario

To choose a response to a scenario:

Choose on an appropriate answer from the selection below the scenario screen.

Or:

Scroll over the answer selection with the **UP** and **DOWN** arrows and press **ENTER**.

See Also: Get a Scenario The character to the left of the screen will change in response to your answers. Choose **hair, eyes, mouth, body, legs, left foot** or **right foot**. The character of the dog will indicate your overall rating as the test progresses.

### **Voice Over**
