INSTALLATION:

PROGRAM

The ARCUS Movie Player requires Apple's QuickTime for Windows 2.0, which is included on the disc.

To install, run the **INSTALL.EXE** program in the **ROOT** directory on the CD-ROM. The installation program installs QuickTime for Windows onto the harddrive of your choice and creates a program group and icons in the Program Manager which point to the CD-ROM drive applications.

Simply click on the ARCUS icon in the ARCUS program group to start. Allow 5-45 seconds to load depending on your system- keep your eye on the drive light.

OPERATING THE ARCUS PLAYER:

When the player appears on the screen, click anywhere on it to open the

controller. The movie can be controlled using the buttons on the left. By clicking on the chapter buttons, you can change to different places in the movie.

The buttons on the right side of the Arcus "A" are book marks. Simply click on the blue button to mark your place and use the green button to it's right to return to that part of the movie anytime. When you return to a bookmark, the screen is set to the smallest size but can be immediately expanded again. Bookmarks do not remain after you quit the application.

The "!" button is hides the application. To bring back the movie, click anywhere on the screen.

The "CNTL" button toggles the QuickTime controller on and off. When the movie is expanded to full screen, the controller is automatically disabled.

The button to the farthest right expands the movie to 640 X 480 pixels. Performance will vary greatly depending on you processor and video card. Click anywhere on the video to return to the player.

The volume can be adjusted using the number keys 1 through 8. The mute key toggles the volume between 0 and the maximum.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS:

To view the movie you should have a 386/33 or better CPU with 8-bit (256 color) or better graphics, a sound card, Microsoft Windows 3.1, DOS 5.0, and a mouse. Your PC should have at least 4MB of RAM, and a double speed CD-ROM drive. A 486/33, 8 megs of RAM and Hi-Color (32,000 colors) is highly recommended.
