## Images on the CD

The \BITMAPS directory on the CD-ROM contains a number of images. On a default Windows configuration, you should be able to view them in Paintbrush by double-clicking on their file name, from within the Explorer.

If you are having trouble getting to the icons, try the following steps with the 3D Screen Saver CD-ROM in the drive:

- Double-click on "My Computer" from the desktop
- Right-click on the 3D Screen Saver CD icon, and select "Open".
- Double-click on the "Bitmaps" folder

The \BITMAPS directory is organized as follows:

ANIM\	These images are high-resolution versions of some shots shown in the animation.
ANIM\24bit	640x480x16 million
ANIM\8bit	1024x768x256 color
EXTRA\	These high-resolution images are a grab-bag of alternate camera shots, details of objects and scenes, and some other images we thought could be interesting
EXTRA\24bit	640x480x16 million
EXTRA\8bit	1024x768x256 color
SKETCH\	These images are the story boards and draft sketches used by the animators to design and create the animations.
SKETCH\	All are within 1024x768x256 colors.

**WARNING:** If you attempt to display a 16 million color image on a 256 color display using Paintbrush, it will take a long time to calculate an optimal palette. The same delay is encountered if a 16 million color image is placed as a background on a 256 color display.

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
