It comes with a 30-day unconditional guarantee: satisfaction or your money back.

## What it is

The Kerning Palette is a kerning table editor, a professional tool for modifying the kern pairs tables of Mac fonts. For those striving to produce the absolute best type they can on their Macintosh, the presence of a fast, convenient kerning table editor inside of QuarkXPress is a terrific advantage. The Xtension consists of only a few simple parts:

- a Menu
- a Floating Palette
- an Export dialog box
- an XPress Preferences... dialog box
- a Preferences dialog box

## Installation

Drop the demo Xtension into your folder containing QuarkXPress. Version 3.1 of The Kerning Palette requires version 3.1 of QuarkXPress. It cheerfully responds under 32-bit addressing. Balloon help is available.
