

Once you have identified the startup files that are causing your problem, you must decide how to best deal with this information.

If there is only one startup file causing the problem, you must disable that item and contact the publisher of the software for an update.

If there are two or more startup files conflicting, you can try to reorder them and see if the problem disappears. The more startup files that are part of the problem, the harder it is to solve it with reordering. The best solution might be to disable one of the problem files.

You can also set up an incompatible link between the startup files.
