Telecommunications Act

The Telecommunications Act of 1996 resides on this disc in two formats. An Icon is installed that will launch the Telecommunications Act in a searchable text browser. The Act also is published in the root directory of the CD-ROM as an ASCII text file named:

TELECOM.TXT

General Installation Notes

SETUP.EXE on the root of this CD-ROM installs the needed program libraries and creates a Program group and icon. Jones Telecommunications and Multimedia Encyclopedia runs off of the CD-ROM. Please make sure that you have the Encyclopedia CD-ROM in your CD drive at all times while using the application.

As part of the installation the setup program will ask you if you want to install QuickTime 2.03. QuickTime is need to run the Encyclopedia. Some applications may need specific versions of QuickTime to run, so you may want to leave a current version of QuickTime on your system. If you should have any problems with audio or video performance we suggest installing the version of QuickTime provided with this CD.

Video Requirements

This program has been designed to run with a video driver that is set to 16 or 24 bit color (thousands of color or more). This program will run in 256 colors, but video, text and graphics will not display properly.

We recommend that your video driver be set to 640x480 resolution to allow play back at full screen. The application will play in higher resolutions but the display area used on the screen will be smaller.
