- 2. The program will copy the image from the first icon to all the others, if any of the files does not have an .info file, then one will be created.
- 3. The program will copy the Tool Types and (tool) from the first icon to all ↔ the others, if the other files, and a .info file will be created if one does not already exist.
- 4. The program will remove the .info files of the selected files.

5. Abort.
