COMMON PARENTING STYLE IN LATINAMERICA

- More than 80% of the children stay at home until they get married (ages 23-35)
- They usually offer financial help to the family.
- Even if they go out to University, they return and stay with the family until they get married.
- This is what families expect from them.




In Latinamerica and the Caribean there are aproximatly 1170 Mother and Baby Friendly Hospitals

- 228 OTHERS


MOTHER AND BABY FRIENDLY HOSPITALS IN MEXICO

- 734 from 919 Public Hospitals are certificated. 57 are still pending.
- In 1994 284 were certificated.
- In 1996 the number grew to 548.
- In 2000 the number reached more than 700.

STUDY MADE TO 18 OUT OF THE 90 PERU'S CERTIFICATED HOSPITALS




BREASTFEEDING DURING THE FIRST SIX MONTHS

 In Mexico, there are born two millions seven hundred kids per year. 16 hundred of them die before they reach 5 years old. 44% of the 16 hundred die due to intestinal infections, desnutrition or severe respiratory infections.

















PORCENTAGE OF NATIVE PEOPLE IN MEXICO







WOMEN OCUPATION (by INEGI)
