

BRAMBLE MAZE

Many items are hidden in the Bramble Maze and it's up to you and Cera to find them! After you help Cera find all of the items on the big rock, you must find the Exit to return home. But beware of Sharktooth, if he finds you you'll drop all your items and have to start over. When you've found all your items and returned Cera home safely, you'll win tree stars. Remember, the more difficult the maze is, the more tree stars you'll win!

BUILD A DINO

Build your own dinosaur by mixing and matching Dino pieces! Click on the bones in the sinking sand to choose your Dino part, then select a piece from the rock above and start constructing. Make them real or imaginary, it's up to you. If you want to start over, click on the trash can to clear the screen. When you have built a dinosaur, you can exit the activity and find out how many tree stars you have won!

CAVE CONCENTRATION

Help Spike figure out which creatures are in which caves. Select two caves and match the creatures that are in inside. Choose the number of caves on the left to change the difficulty of this activity. Keep your eyes open, the creatures will try to fool you by switching which caves they are in when you are on a harder level. When you have matched all the creatures, you'll win more tree stars!

COLORING BOOK

Color pictures of your favorite characters in this coloring book. To begin, choose a picture you like using the arrows on the right side of the screen. After that, choose a color from the rainbow and click the tool you want to use. Now you can start coloring! If your pencil gets dull, use the sharpener. If your brush needs more paint, dip it in the paint can. When you like what you see, click on the footprint on the right side of the screen to print your picture. For each picture you paint, you'll win a tree star!

If you want to hear the question again, click the text. If you want to hear another question, click the arrow pointing up. You get more tree stars if you can answer questions about actual Dino facts!

EGG ROLL

Littlefoot needs your help to get the egg to safety. Place objects from the left side of the screen in the egg's path to guide it to the nest at the bottom. Use the objects to change the direction of the egg, make a bridge for the egg, give the egg a cushion, or give the egg a ramp. Use the small lava rivers on the left to choose your level of skill. If you help get the egg to safety so it hatches, you'll win tree stars!

FLYING GAME

Help Littlefoot or one of his friends fly across the river and land safely in the tall grass. Click on a character to place them on a tree, then use the arrow keys on the rocks at the bottom to position the tree and how far it is bent. When you are ready to send them on their way, click the dinosaur holding the rope. Use the different sized palm trees on the right to choose your level of skill. The higher the level, the more objects you must avoid hitting. When you land them safely in the grass on the other side, you'll win a tree star, or maybe more!

MAKE A STORY

Then, try to put the sentences in the right order by dragging them up and down the list. The top is the beginning and the bottom is the end. Tech Notes

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WINDOWS 3.1

1. Insert the CD-ROM into the drive.
2. Open the Program Manager window.
3. From the File menu choose Run.
4. In the Command Line box, type your CD-ROM drive letter followed by the name of the installation file -- INSTALL.EXE
For example, if your CD-ROM drive is the D:\ drive, you would type the following text into the Command Line box: D:\INSTALL.EXE
5. Click on OK.
6. Follow the directions on the screen.

WINDOWS 95

1. Insert the CD-ROM into the drive. On most Windows 95 systems, the Autoplay feature will run the installation automatically. To prevent this (if you want to do a hard disk install), hold down the <SHIFT> key for a few seconds immediately after inserting the CD-ROM.
2. Click on Start button (at the bottom of the screen.)
3. Click on Explore.
4. Double-click on the CD-ROM icon to open a CD-ROM window.
5. Double-click on INSTALL.EXE in the CD-ROM drive window.
6. Follow the directions on the screen.

Note: You may also right-click on the CD-ROM drive icon in My Computer to receive a menu of choices, including Autoplay (the default if you double-click), this Readme file, and Install.

GENERAL TROUBLE SHOOTING TIPS

Optimizing Your System

If you experience problems with your program, we recommend you try the following:

CD-ROM's

CD-ROMs are durable, but not indestructible. If you encounter problems, you need to check for scratches on both sides of the disc. Scratches can render a disc useless, especially if the scratch chips off any of the silver coating. Scratches can also cause problems with reading the disc, which then causes read failures.

If you're using SMARTDRV.EXE, add /X and /U to the command line to disable caching features that may interfere with smooth CD-ROM performance.

Video

Out-of-date video drivers can cause problems. If you experience problems with your video card, we recommend that you contact the card manufacturer and obtain the most current drivers. Most manufacturers produce updated drivers several times every year. It's a good idea to regularly check for updates.

You may experience problems when running at higher video resolutions, or with a large number of colors. We've optimized our program to run in 640x480x256 colors. If you encounter problems, we recommend that you set your video to this resolution before running the program.

Memory

The more programs you have running in Windows at one time, the less memory is available for our

program to use. This may result in an insufficient memory error message. To check which applications are currently running, open your task list by pressing <CTRL+ESC>. Close any unnecessary applications and then rerun our program.

Disable any wallpaper you may have open in the background. This will free up memory for our program to use.

Make sure you have a permanent swap file allocated that is 7-10 megabytes in size. You may be losing out on accessible memory if you have a smaller swap file. (For more information about swap files, please refer to your Microsoft Windows documentation.) Note: Windows 95 users should let Windows 95 control the size of their swap file instead of setting it manually.

Audio

Make sure that you've installed and properly set up the most current drivers for your sound card.

Make sure that your DMA, IRQ, and Port Address settings in Windows match the settings on your sound and video cards.

If you do not hear any sound when running the program, make sure that the mixer control for your soundcard is turned up to an appropriate level. You should also make sure that your speakers are properly plugged into the sound card.
