

Each issue of MYSTERY ADVENTURE MAGAZINE featured a great cover by prolific pulp artist Norman Saunders. Saunders was one of the giants of pulp illustration, painting for nearly every major pulp publisher and for every genre, including western, weird menace, science fiction, spicy and adventure. For several years, he produced an incredible average of two paintings per week. Although he published his work for MYSTERY ADVENTURE MAGAZINE under his name, for some of his more explicit work, such as that for SAUCY MOVIE TALES, Saunders used the name Blaine. In addition to Saunders' cover, the highlight of this particular issue was the second Zenith Rand story, "Revenge On Scylla."
