An action-packed cover by H.J. Ward gets the September 1938 issue of SPICY ADVENTURE STORIES off to a good start. Inside are all of the usual suspects, including Hugh Cave/Justin Case with "Tomorrow You Die." In 1995, a second mammoth collection of Hugh Cave's pulp tales was published, this time from Fedogan & Bremer, under the title DEATH STALKS THE NIGHT. The collection has been nominated for a richly deserved World Fantasy Award, and more Hugh Cave collections are planned, including THE DAGGER OF TSIANG AND OTHER TALES OF ADVENTURE, a collection of some of Cave's best pulp adventure fiction, due to be published in the summer of 1997 by Tattered Pages Press.
