"China Charter" by Clint Morgan kicks off the October 1936 issue of SPICY ADVENTURE STORIES. Once you get past the Parkhurst cover, that is. The cover this time out would have almost been home on WEIRD TALES, as it is reminiscent of some of Margaret Brundage's covers for that pulp. Morgan, who appeared frequently in the spicy pulps, may have been either a housename or a pseudonym, but it is unlikely that it is his real name.
