SAUCY DETECTIVE was a short-lived companion title to SAUCY MOVIE STORIES, lasting for 5 issues from March 1937 through August 1937 (the final issue appearing under the title SAUCY DETECTIVE STORIES). In an unusual move for a pulp magazine, most of the cover paintings were not attributed to an artist, but rather to the Shipman Studios (sometimes with the artist at such studio identified by first name). SAUCY DETECTIVE is a collector's nightmare, in that most issues only mention the month of publication (on the cover and spine) with no indication of year of publication. Fortunately for indexers, it was only published during 1937.
