

Demonstrating the use of pseudonyms in the spicy pulps, the July 1938 issue of SPICY DETECTIVE STORIES is a prime example. Of the eight stories in the issue, only one is clearly published under the author's real name, Robert Leslie Bellem, present with "Killer's Harvest". Of the other seven authors, three are Bellem pseudonyms--Jerome Severs Perry, Harley L. Court and Ellery Watson Calder--while Robert A. Garron is Howard Wandrei, N. Wooten Poge is Norvell Page, and William B. Rainey is prolific pulpster Wyatt Blassingame. The final author in the mix, Horton Jacques, is unknown, but odds are it, too, was made-up.
