Prolific spicy scribe Cary Moran appears in the September 1936 issue of SPICY DETECTIVE STORIES with "Fatal Facial." Moran, whose real name was likely something else and remains unknown, wrote several series for the spicy pulps. "Fatal Facial" was a tale of one of his spicy detectives, Jarnegan. Three Jarnegan stories, including this one, were reprinted in 1987 in SPICY DETECTIVE ENCORES NO. 6 from Winds of the World Press, which also collected "Case of the Limber Corpse" (May 1937) and "Murder In the Sheriff's Office" (January 1937).
