

The March 1938 issue of SPICY MYSTERY STORIES features "Graveyard Curse" by Henry Kuttner splashed across the cover. Kuttner, a fine writer of science fiction and fantasy, was an infrequent contributor to the spicy pulps-- at least under his own name. The April and May issues of SPICY MYSTERY would feature Kuttner stories, and then he disappears from the contents pages until one final story appears in the July 1941 issue. Kuttner was later married to C.L. Moore, another top pulp writer best remembered for her fantasy stories, and the two collaborated on many stories in the 1940's.
