Editor and publisher Robert Price, perhaps best known for his publication, CRYPT OF CTHULHU and the various collections of Cthulhu stories he has edited, instituted a bit of a one man pulp revival in the mid-1980's with various pulp-style magazines paying homage to the heyday of the pulps, with such titles as SHUDDER STORIES (for weird menace folks), ASTRO ADVENTURES and RISQUE STORIES (for connoisseurs of the spicy pulps). In addition to fiction, these 'zines often printed articles on the pulp genre which they covered, and pulp historian Will Murray contributed several fine articles on the spicy pulps for RISQUE STORIES, which are well worth tracking down.
