Ward's cover for the December 1935 issue of SPICY MYSTERY STORIES is unusual in that the woman in peril, for once, doesn't possess the massive mammaries common to the spicy pulps. In all other respects, however, it fits the spicy mold, so perhaps we should forgive Ward this oversight just this once. Inside, Victor Rousseau, writing as Hugh Speer, takes the award for best story title with "She Who Was He!"
