

Unlike the classic Saunders covers which graced the earlier issues of SAUCY MOVIE TALES, the issues published in mid-1937 featured covers by an anonymous artist, probably done through the Shipman Studios like its sister title, SAUCY DETECTIVE, which, while lacking the explicit realism of Saunders' covers, still were vibrant and pushing the envelope of the spicy pulp genre. On the cover of the August 1937 issue, "Pirates' Woman" shows off the latest in buccaneer swimwear.
