

SAUCY MOVIE TALES featured some of the finest "girlie" art in the pulps, courtesy of artist Norman Saunders who, both under his own name and his Blaine pseudonym, contributed many covers to the title. Many of these were racier than the competing SPICY line of pulps, such as that for the October 1936 issue, which features a man cupping a woman's breast. In the way of fiction (people bought these to read, right?), the November 1936 issue features "Red Sails in the Sunset" by Lars Anderson, author of the Domino Lady stories for SMT's sister publication, SAUCY ROMANTIC ADVENTURES. Unfortunately, the masked crime fighter never appeared in SAUCY MOVIE TALES.
