The November 1937 issue of SAUCY MOVIE TALES is the only issue to be published by Solon Publishing (prior issues were published by Movie Digest, Inc., and later issues by Newsdealers Magazine Co.). Although pulp titles were occassionally sold (such as FRONTIER STORIES, which was sold by Doubleday Doran to Fiction House in the late 1920s), it seems likely that this change in the publisher of SAUCY MOVIE TALES was a change in name only, as opposed to a real change in ownership. Lars Anderson of the Domino Lady fame contributes the cover story this time out, "Sins of Hollywood!".
