The January 1945 issue of SPEED DETECTIVE STORIES features three stories by author Victor Rousseau, today most remembered for his science fiction pulp stories, though he was a prolific author who wrote for nearly every genre. He appears here with "Swords for Florence" under his own name, "Get Your Man!" under his Lew Merrill penname and "The Brides of Coco Island" under his Clive Trent moniker. Hugh Cave, however, copped the cover with "No Man's Island."
