

UNCANNY TALES gasped its last with the May 1940 issue. However, to confuse collectors, an unrelated Canadian pulp also entitled UNCANNY TALES began publication shortly thereafter, with its first issue appearing in November 1940. This entry from north of the border was not a weird menace pulp, but rather was a straight science fiction magazine and, for its first four issues, was in a large digest format, rather than a true pulp format. Turning our focus back to the weird menace incarnation of UNCANNY TALES, as was the case with each of the previous four issues, the best feature of the final issue of UNCANNY TALES was its cover and story titles.
