Evolution

MS-Access under Winslows, but since June '95 I am working on a hypertext based information system about Concurrent Engineering using Toolbook.

An important part of the computer science studies in Bremen is a student project which lasts for 4 semesters. I am participant of the "NetVision" project where a system is developed on Apple Macintoshes in which a couple of people can move around in a virtual world, communicate with each other and create / modify the world together e.g. by creating multi-media documents.

My "computer career" started in mid '84 with the VIC-20 which was (of course) replaced by a C-64 one year later which finally had to leave my desk for an Amiga 500 with Kick 1.2 in January '88. On the Amiga 500 I mostly worked on assembler programming and coding a few demos and intros - yEaH, c00L StUfF, which entirely doesn't work anymore today. :-D

Mid '91 even the A500 had to go and was replaced by an A2000C on which this text (ok, the GERMAN version - [the editor]) is just being written. This machine was "armed to the teeth" over the years: with a G-Force '040/33 (12 MB), C= flicker fixer, Picasso II 2 MB, 2 240 MB harddisks, an 88 MB Syquest and a double-speed CD-ROM, accompanied by a 17" monitor, TKR 14.4 Modem and HP Laserjet IIIp. Two ICs were ripped out of the motherboard of the A2000 so that it now houses OS 3.1 (40.63) as well as a HiRes denise.

I soon stopped demo coding on the A2000 - I had noticed that this kind of "hardware banging" makes no real sense and system conformant programming is much more fun. So, (also as a result of the studies) I purchased the M2 Modula-2 compiler and started some first steps under AmigaOS.

By entering the world of modems, mailboxes and the like in april '93 and whilst searching for a reasonable frontend for the MausNet I got in contact with Stefan 'ToolManager' Becker who introduced me to the Universal Message System (UMS) which immediately inspired me. So I decided to use my programming skills <ahem> to support UMS and developed my only larger project: ConfUMS, a configuration editor for UMS. Besides that, a few small UMS tools written by me can be found on Aminet, among them UMSMailStat, a statistics tool for newsgroups.

Do pearls meet ?

Being enthusiastic about the concept of the first Meeting Pearls CD, I wanted to contribute something to the MP2. At first I only thought about a UMS installation, but Bernhard~'ZZA' Moellemann persuaded me to take over the entire comm/ directory. As I had a lot of fun putting together the files for the MP2, I decided to also take part in the creation of the MP3. I chose the util/ directory without any special reasons - but for the sake for variety I didn't want to take over comm/ again.

Strictly speaking I did not take part in the Meeting Pearls, but only in the pearls: so far there were always some important matches or tournaments that prevented me from attending a meeting. :-(

And now for something completely different...

If I am not hanging around in front of my computer's screen, fighting my way through BEGINs, ENDs or Mails, you can sometimes find me on Basketball playgrounds. I am playing in a union for 8 years, currently in the "Verbandsliga Bremen" at the SC Weyhe (Weyhe is a small town south-east of Bremen). My basketball relevant data: 198 cm tall, about
