Unfortunately, most of them can't be run just by clicking on their icons but they have to be configured properly first. Please read the corresponding documentation for more information about that.

If a program needs an assign to save files there is a simple trick which works under AmogaOS 2.0 and above:

There was not enough space on this CD (yes, this happens even with CDs!) so I had to delete some parts of almost every package (e.g. documentation in DVI and PostScript) and store source code in an LZX archives.

1.2 amosaic

AMosaic

You'll find a prerelease of AMosaic 2.0 on this CD which now finally supports forms. There are still some bugs left in this version but in my opinion it works better than the older releases.

There is one version for AmiTCP, AS225 and a NoNet version which runs without any network. All these version require AmigaOS 3.0 so I also included AMosaic 1.2 NoNet for AmigaOS 2.0 users (but there are no inlined images on AmigaOS 2.x - sorry). If you click on the Mosaic icons in the root directory of this CD you will probably get the right version for your system.

1.3 amirc

Amiga MicroIRC

First, I wanted to install Grapevine (the IRC client by Brian J. Cerveny) on this CD but unfortunately the author did not give me permission to do so. I thought that there really should be an IRC client on this CD so I asked Oliver Wagner if I may include his client "Amiga MircoIRC" which is still an alpha version. As all basic functions are implemented and working, he agreed. Thanks Olli!

1.4 trapdoor

I extracted the archives "td_1_84.lha", "ts_1_7.lha" and "fidonet.lha" from the original distribution into one common directory and included the German TrapDoor documentation by Marc Führer in the docs directory. Furthermore, I applied the patch from 1.84 to 1.85 and added the changes file to the beginning of "Changes-TD".

MultiLink

As newer version of ncftp (e.g. from AmiTCP 4.0demo) won't run with MLink, I have included version 1.5.6 on thois CD. Please use this version as ftp client for MLink.
