

Ordering Pegasus Mail Manuals

Pegasus Mail is free software (note: *NOT* shareware and *NOT* freeware), and is provided with enough documentation to be easily installed and usable: but no manual is provided.

In order to support the considerable costs of hardware and software involved in developing Pegasus Mail, I sell printed manuals. There is no obligation to purchase manuals - none whatsoever. Purchasing manuals does, however, help me in my work and also gives you a tangible asset for your money. The manual is provided loose-leaf in a protective folder, ready for copying. The quality of the manual is high.

I sell manuals in two ways:

10-user manuals: you get one printed manual with a license to make up to 10 further copies. This costs US\$175.

Site-licensed manuals: you get one printed manual with a license to make as many copies as you wish for one site. One site is defined as the extent of any organization in any one city or town, so if you have two branches in the same town, one site license will cover both of them. As well as the manual, site licensees get a diskette with RTF and ASCII versions of the manual. Site licenses cost US\$350, or US\$525 for a combined site license covering both the Windows and Mac versions of Pegasus Mail.

Any type of manual can be upgraded to the next level for the current difference in cost between the two levels.

Ordering manuals

To order a Pegasus Mail Manual license, please print and fill out the order form at the end of this file and send it with your cheque or purchase order to:

Purchase orders are accepted from any educational or charitable institution or government department, and from companies with a paid up capital in excess of \$30,000.

Payment must be made in US dollars, drawn on a US bank. There is usually a delay of at least 2-3 weeks before a manual can be sent out, and I reserve the right to hold your order if a new release is pending (so you can get the new release). We can also accept payment by VISA or Mastercard.

PLEASE, PLEASE! Remember to enclose the order form: we're not psychic, and can't guess at delivery addresses from a cheque alone...

Manuals are always shipped by courier (3-4 days to most places in the world); the transport costs are extra, and are shown in a table below. For a variety of reasons, we cannot ship Federal Express nor UPS, nor can we charge freight to account numbers.

Telegraphic Transfers

We will accept payment by telegraphic transfer, but there are some very particular conditions you **MUST** meet for me to be able to do so.

- Your bank must not deduct any fees from the amount invoiced.
- Transfer to: The National Bank of New Zealand, Dunedin North Branch, account 060-909-0106632-13, account name "David Harris Pegasus Mail".
- Your bank *MUST ONLY TRANSFER TO MY BANK!!!* If your bank transfers to me via any other bank in New Zealand, it will incur processing fees at this end which I will not accept. If your bank cannot transfer directly to the National Bank of New Zealand, please pay by cheque. *PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR BANK UNDERSTANDS THIS CONDITION!* Please note that "The National Bank of New Zealand" and "The Bank of New Zealand" are completely separate organizations.
- Please make sure that your bank states my invoice number in the transfer narration, so I can credit the remittance against your invoice.

Orders from Europe

A note to European users: it appears to be common practice for European Banks, particularly in Germany, to deduct fees from the cheque they send. In some cases, these fees have been as high as US\$15.

Because of the costs of manual production, and the relatively small amounts involved in the invoice, *DEDUCTIONS OF FEES FROM REMITTANCES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED!* If your bank deducts fees from the remittance you make, I will return the cheque unrepresented for repayment.

Upgrading existing manuals

If you have purchased a previous version of the Pegasus Mail manual, you can upgrade it to the current version for US\$135, irrespective of the original type. A box is provided on the order form for upgrades - please check it when you send out the order. No proof of purchase is required - we have all the details on record.

If you have already purchased a Pegasus Mail Site License for one platform of the program (for instance, DOS, Windows), you can claim a discount of US\$75 on a site license for any other platform version of the system.

Credit card orders

We can accept payment by Mastercard or VISA - please complete the section on the order form as shown below, making sure you print or type clearly. Credit card payments may not appear on your statement as the exact amount you expect because we have to submit the charge in New Zealand dollars. We cannot accept Diners card or American Express.

Freight

Manuals are shipped via courier to any location in the world. The delivery time is usually 3-4 days and is fully traced. Freight costs are as follows:

When ordering one manual, add:

To Australia/New Zealand	US\$15.00
To the U.S.A. and Canada	US\$27.50
To the U.K. and Europe	US\$32.50
All other destinations	US\$37.50

When ordering two or more manuals, or any Bundle option, add:

To Australia/New Zealand	US\$20.00
To the U.S.A. and Canada	US\$34.00
To the U.K. and Europe	US\$39.00
All other destinations	US\$45.00

Other conditions

- US Taxpayer information requests: the vendor is not a US Citizen, and is not resident in the USA for tax purposes. Requests for FEINs or SSNs will be ignored (I don't have any and have confirmed with the US Embassy in Sydney Australia that I am not in any sense obligated to respond).
- Quotes, bids, acknowledgments: because of the sheer volume of paperwork we have to process, we cannot provide quotes, bids or acknowledgments of receipt of order other than via electronic mail.
