If you start Home Publishing while the computer is set to a display resolution of 640x480, you may receive the following error message:

Your screen is currently displayed in low resolution.

For the best looking display, open the Windows Control Panel, double-click Display, Click the Settings tab, and set Desktop Area to 800x600 and Font Size to Small Fonts.

When you click OK, Home Publishing will start.

MORE INFORMATION

The screens and menus in Home Publishing were designed to be displayed in a resolution of 800x600 or greater. While not a requirement, Home Publishing will look better when viewed at greater than 640x480. This setting will not affect the printed output or the way the project displays on other systems.

Selecting the "Don't show this message again" option will keep this message from appearing.

To change the resolution, follow these steps.

Because there are several versions of Windows, the following steps may be different on your computer. If they are, please consult your product documentation to complete these steps.

- 1. Click Start, point to Settings, and then click Control Panel.
- 2. In Control Panel, double-click the Display icon.
- 3. In the Display Properties dialog box, click the Settings tab, and set the Desktop Area to 800x600 and Font Size to Small Fonts.
