SUMMARY

The pre-designed templates included with Home Publishing have been optimized to use small fonts. Setting the system to use large fonts may cause the layout of text related to objects to be affected and other elements to be clipped. You can avoid this by using small fonts or by reformatting the text in the template to better fit the layout.

To set the system so that it uses small fonts, follow these steps.

NOTE: Because there are several versions of Windows, the following steps may be different on your computer. If they are, please consult your product documentation to complete these steps.

- 1. Click Start, point to Settings, and then click Control Panel.
- 2. In Control Panel, double-click the Display icon.
- 3. In the Display Properties box, click the Settings tab.
- 4. Click the arrow in the Font Size box, and select Small Fonts.
- 5. Click OK.
- 6. Restart the computer.
