Picture It! will detect a digital camera if you have the TWAIN drivers for the camera installed. Casio digital cameras come with TWAIN drivers, usually on a separate disk labeled "TWAIN Modulator".

To install the Casio TWAIN driver, do the following:

1. Run the Setup.exe program on the TWAIN disk.

-or-

Double-click the TWAIN folder on the disk.

2. Install or reinstall Picture It!.

The Casio QV-family of digital cameras use software called QV Link or QV PC, depending on the model. This software does not by itself support TWAIN. TWAIN is a special protocol that allows Windows applications to communicate with digital cameras and scanners.

At this writing, Casio cameras ship with TWAIN version 1.5. Picture It! uses TWAIN version 1.6. Installing or reinstalling Picture It! after you install TWAIN for the camera ensures that Picture It! has the correct versions of the files it needs.
