Note: In slide-show mode, you can activate hyperlinks with a single-click.

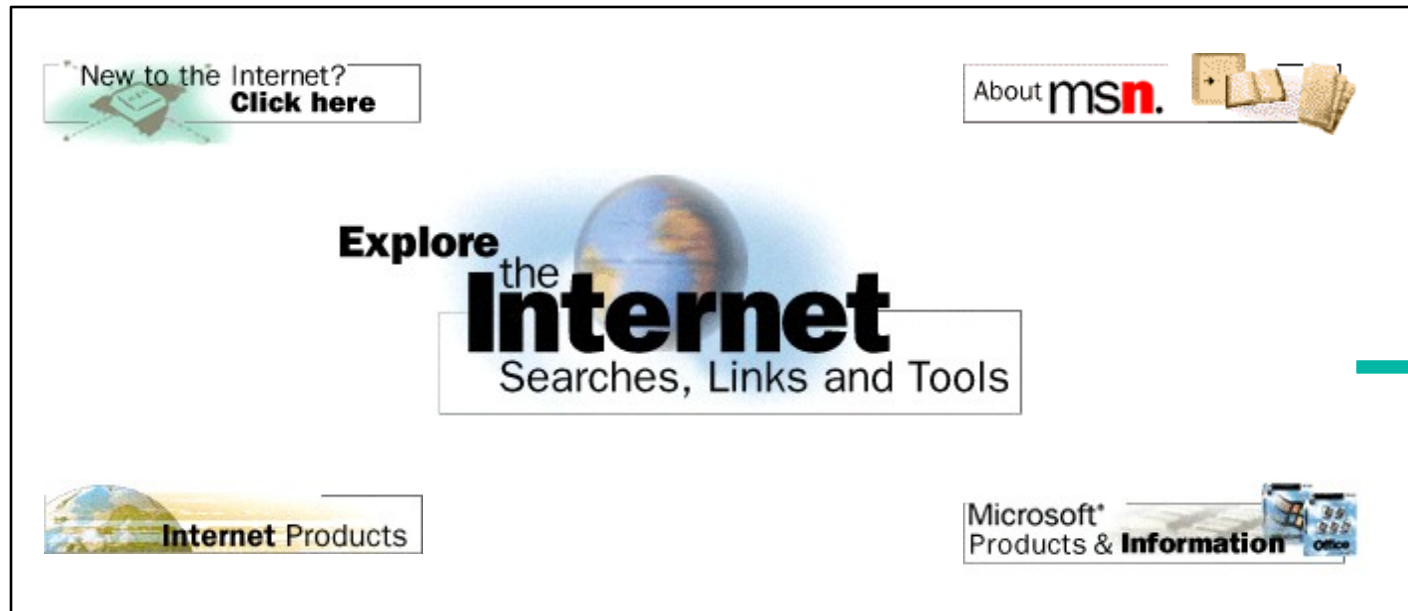
CyberButton
