

## IconMotion Icon Animator

IconMotion lets you place animated icons anywhere on your Windows Desktop. Animations can be placed on Program Manager icons, Norton Desktop Quick Access Group items, minimized windows, or anywhere!

### To place an animated icon:

- o Select the icon you want to place from the list. It will be shown in the Example area.
- o Select the example icon with the *left* mouse button. IconMotion will become minimized so you can view more of your desktop.
- o While holding the left mouse button, drag the icon to the desired location. If you want the animation to replace a shell icon or the icon for a minimized program, be sure the cursor is over the icon you're replacing.

*Note:* If you do not want to place the icon anywhere, drop it over the minimized IconMotion window, which now resembles a trash can.

- o Release the mouse button.
- o You can continue to place other icons. When done, press OK to minimize IconMotion.

*Note:* Pressing Exit will turn off all animations and exit IconMotion.

### To move or remove an animation:

- o Press the Move... button. The cursor will change to resemble a hand.
- o Click on the animation with the *left* mouse button. IconMotion will become minimized so you can view more of your desktop.
- o Drag the icon to its new location. If you want to remove the animation from the desktop, drag it to the minimized IconMotion window.

### To set IconMotion to load automatically whenever you start Windows:

- o Press the Autoload button. This will insert a copy of IconMotion into your Startup group.

### To stop IconMotion loading automatically whenever you start Windows:

- o Press the Don't load button. This will remove the copy of IconMotion from your Startup group.
